Activities in Brief:

1.1 The Chief Justice of Pakistan's visit



Honourable the Chief Justice of Pakistan Mr. Justice Tassaduq Hussain Jilani, visited KP Judicial Academy on January 13, 2014. On this occasion, he inaugurated the Dost Muhammad Khan Mediation Centre, which is the first of its kind established in Pakistan to resolve cases through institutionalized mediation. The CJP visited various sections of the Academy including Research Wing, academy's library and studios of Radio Meezan. He was briefed on the various activities conducted in the Academy.

His lordship delivered speech at the concluding ceremony of second training on Substantive and Procedural Laws. During his speech, he lauded the tiresome efforts of the Chief Justice PHC, Justice Dost Muhammad Khan for the establishment of the Judicial Academy. Later, the CJP distributed

certificates amongst the participants of the training.

1.2 UN Delegation Visit



The UN Assistant Secretary General and UNDP Asia-Pacific Bureau Director Mr. Xu Haoliang visited the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Judicial Academy Peshawar on January 25, 2014. The UNDP team along with Country Director for Pakistan Mr. Marc-André Franche visited various sections of the Academy including the ongoing training session, Research Wing, Library, Radio Meezan studios, Dost Muhammad Khan Mediation Center. A briefing was also given to the team about the progress of KP's first Mobile Court.

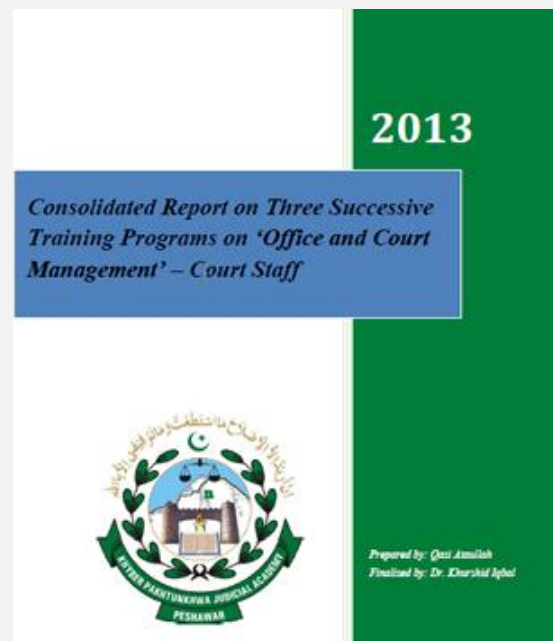
1.4 Dinner hosted in honour of the outgoing Chairman
