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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

On May 16, 2025, a delegation of final semester LLB students from Khyber Law College, University of Peshawar, led by Professor Hassan Khalil, visited the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Judicial Academy (KPJA) as part of an academic exposure initiative. The visit was designed to bridge classroom learning with real-world judicial practices and institutional knowledge. In line with its commitment to academic engagement, KPJA hosted a comprehensive orientation and interaction session with faculty and students.

The program commenced with a welcome address by Mr. Dost Muhammad Khan, Senior Director Administration, followed by presentations and interactive discussions led by Ms. Faryal Zia Mufti, Director Instructions-II, and Mr. Zia-ur-Rehman, Dean Faculty KPJA. These sessions introduced students to the judicial system of Pakistan, the operational framework of the Academy, and emerging trends in legal education and training. Students also visited various Wings of KPJA, gaining valuable insights into its academic, administrative, and research functions.

PROCEEDINGS

Arrival and Welcome Ceremony

The visit began with a formal welcome extended to the delegation of LLB final semester students from Khyber Law College, University of Peshawar, led by Professor Hassan Khalil. The ceremony was attended by senior officers of KPJA, including Mr. Zia-ur-Rehman (Dean Faculty), Mr. Dost Muhammad Khan (Senior Director Administration), Ms. Hina Khan (Director Instructions-I), Ms. Faryal Zia Mufti (Director Instructions-II), and Mr. Wajid Ali (Director Instructions-III).

Mr. Dost Muhammad Khan, in his welcome remarks, shared the vision, mandate, and achievements of the Judicial Academy since its inception in 2012. Tour and Department Visits

The students were given a guided tour of the Academy, where they visited key wings including the Academic Wing, Research & Publication Section, Library, IT Lab, and Media Studio. The visit allowed them to observe the operations of a modern judicial training institution first-hand.

Souvenir Exchange and Closing Remarks

The visit concluded with the exchange of souvenirs between KPJA and Khyber Law College, symbolizing mutual respect and commitment to continued collaboration.

In the end, Professor Hassan Khalil expressed gratitude for KPJA's hospitality and praised the Academy's role in strengthening legal education and judicial capacity in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.
