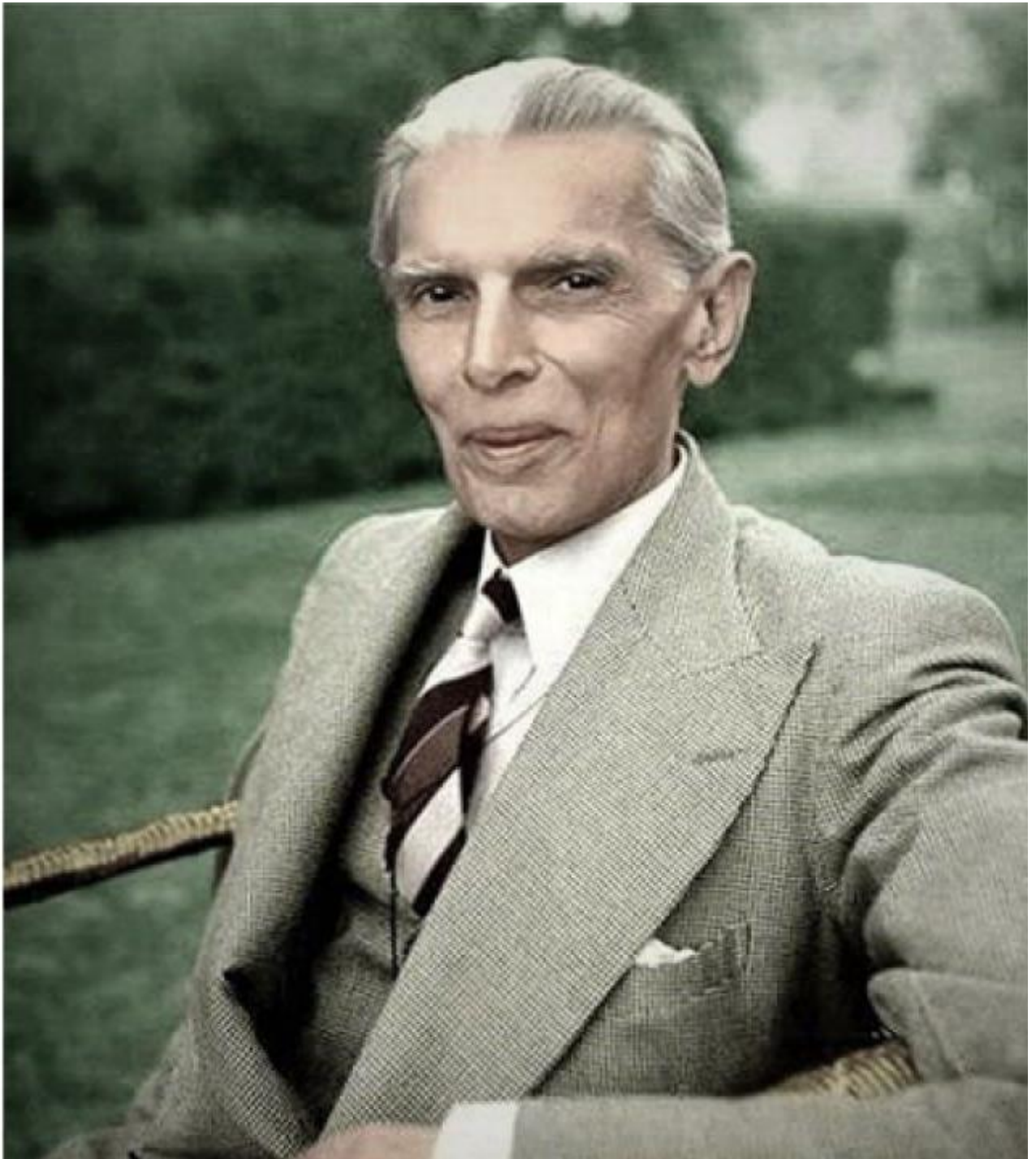

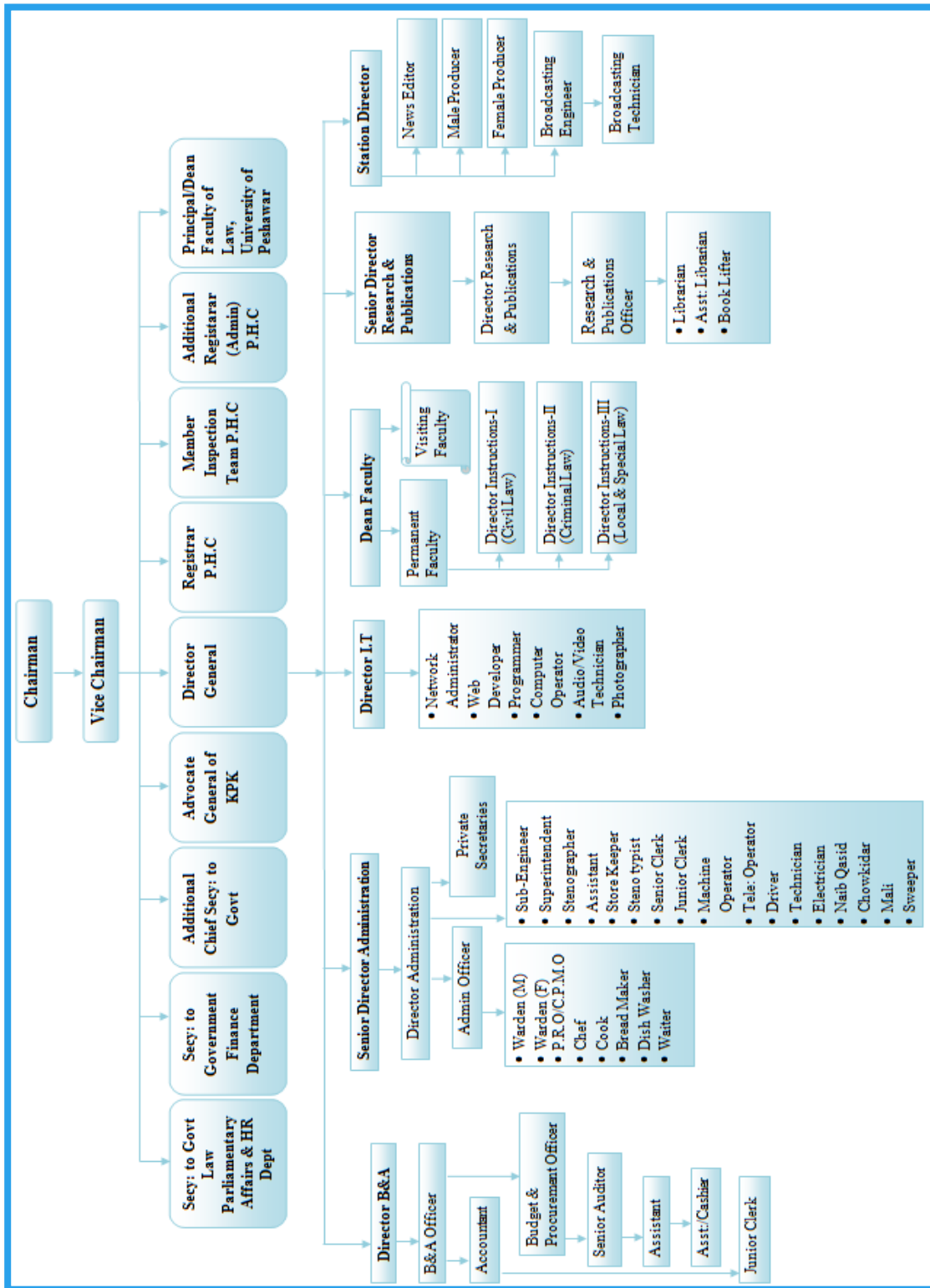
CHAPTER 1

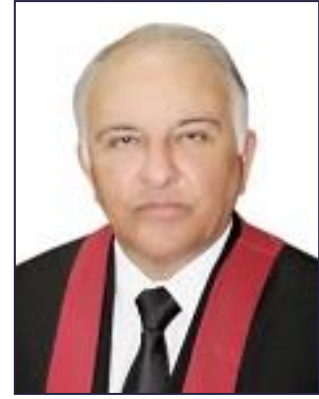

Role and powers of the Board of Governors

The Board of Governors shall:

- a.** exercise supervision and control over the affairs of the Academy;
- b.** lay down the policy and program for training;
- c.** initiate, modify, adopt the curriculum, courses, modules, clinics, for orientation and training;
- d.** organize and carry out the activities and performance of the authority;
- e.** consider and approve the annual budget and revised budget estimate of the Academy;
- f.** manage financial affairs;
- g.** cause proper books of account to be maintained for all sums of money received and expenditure incurred by the Academy and arrange for audit of accounts;
- h.** specify qualifications, conditions of service and matters relating to the director general, faculty members and staff of the Academy;
- i.** create, abolish, suspend and upgrade posts;
- j.** purchase, hire, construct or alter any building for the use of the Academy;
- k.** acquire, hold, control, maintain, administer, construct or dispose of any property, or other assets;
- l.** acquire, maintain and dispose of any vehicle;
- m.** affiliate the Academy with other academies, institutions and centers of the federal, provincial or foreign government and organizations;
- n.** appoint advisors, consultants and experts and specify their terms and conditions;
- o.** appoint or hire permanent or visiting faculty and specify their terms and conditions; and
- p.** decide any other matter ancillary or incidental to aims and objectives of the Academy.

Mr. Justice Qaiser Rashid Khan graduated from Khyber Law College, Peshawar in the year 1984. He did his Masters in Political Science (1987) and Journalism (1991) from University of Peshawar. He started his professional career in 1984 when he was enrolled as an Advocate of the District Bar and later, he was enrolled as an Advocate of the High Court in 1991 as an advocate of the Supreme Court in 2008.

He also worked as an Additional Advocate General, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa from 17.3.2008 to 25.3.2010. He remained legal advisor of the University of Engineering & Technology, Peshawar, National Bank of Pakistan, United Bank Limited, Askari Commercial Bank, Allied Bank Limited and the Bank of Khyber.

His Judicial career started in the year 2011 when he was elevated to the bench as an Additional Judge on 02.8.2011. He was appointed as a permanent judge of Peshawar High Court on 12.6.2013. Appointed as Election Tribunal for hearing appeals of the constituencies of National Assembly as well as Provincial Assembly of KPK on 17th July, 2013.

He took oath as an Acting Chief Justice of the Peshawar High Court on 16.9.2020 and took oath as Chief Justice of the Peshawar High Court on 09.01.2021.

Mr. Justice Rooh ul Amin Khan graduated from Khyber Law College, University of Peshawar in the year 1985.

He remained Deputy Attorney General for Pakistan, Deputy Advocate General, NWFP, Special Government Pleader, NWFP, Service Tribunal, Advocate of the Federal Shariat Court, Islamabad.

He also remained standing council and legal advisor to various public and autonomous institutions including Khyber Teaching Hospital, Leady Reading Hospital, Income Tax Department, WAPDA, PESCO, Pakistan Customs etc.

He started his Judicial career in the year 2012 when he was elevated to the Bench as an Additional Judge of the Peshawar High Court. He was confirmed as a permanent Judge of the Peshawar High Court on, March 2014.

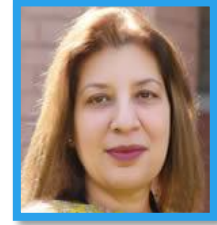

Director General

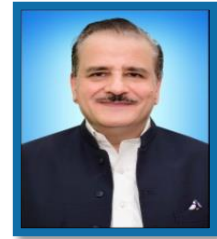

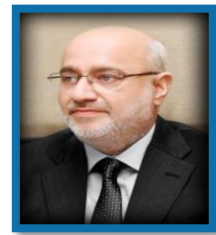
Research & Publication Cadre

Director General

Appointment, powers and functions of the Director General

- a.** Under section 7 of the Act, the Director General is appointed by the Chairman on such terms and conditions as may be approved by the Board.
- b.** Under section 8 of the Act, he manages the affairs of the Academy under the general directions of the Chairman;
- c.** He is the academic and administrative head. He is also the Principal Accounting Officer of the Academy.
- d.** He is the Drawing & Disbursing Officer of the Academy.
- e.** He executes the policy, set out by the Board of Governors (BOG).

Appointment of Officers and Employees of the Academy

The employees of the Academy are appointed through initial recruitment, by promotion, or by deputation in such a manner and on such terms and conditions as envisaged in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Judicial Academy Staff (Terms & Conditions of Service) Rules, 2012.

Appointments of the officers to posts in Basic Pay Scale 17 and above are made by the Chairman. All appointments of the employees to posts in Basic Pay Scale 1 to 16 are made by the Director General with the approval of the Chairman.

Additional Accounts

- In pursuance of recommendations by the Finance Committee of the Academy held on 23.02.2022 and after approval by the Board of Governors of the Academy in the 13th meeting held on 23.06.2022, Finance Department, Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa agreed to allocate funds amounting Rs. 155.000 million as grant-in-aid for the current financial year 2022-23.
- During 2022, a sum of Rs. 5,770,307/- was earned from trainings, workshops and seminars. After approval of Hon'ble the Chief Justice, Peshawar High Court, Peshawar/Chairman, the earning along with some of the balance of Rs. 6,184,000/- was transferred to Endowment Fund in March, 2022 for strengthening the same.
- A profit of Rs. 21,816,000/- is expected from the investment made by the Academy towards Endowment Fund kept in Bank of Khyber, Peshawar High Court Branch, Peshawar.

Endowment Fund

To make the Academy self-sustainable and to reduce its dependency on Provincial Government, Endowment Fund was created during the year 2012-13. Initially, an amount of Rs 50.000 million was released by the Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa as seed money. The profit & earnings of the Academy were re-invested over the period, 2013-22 as per details given below: -

CHAPTER 3 ACADEMICS

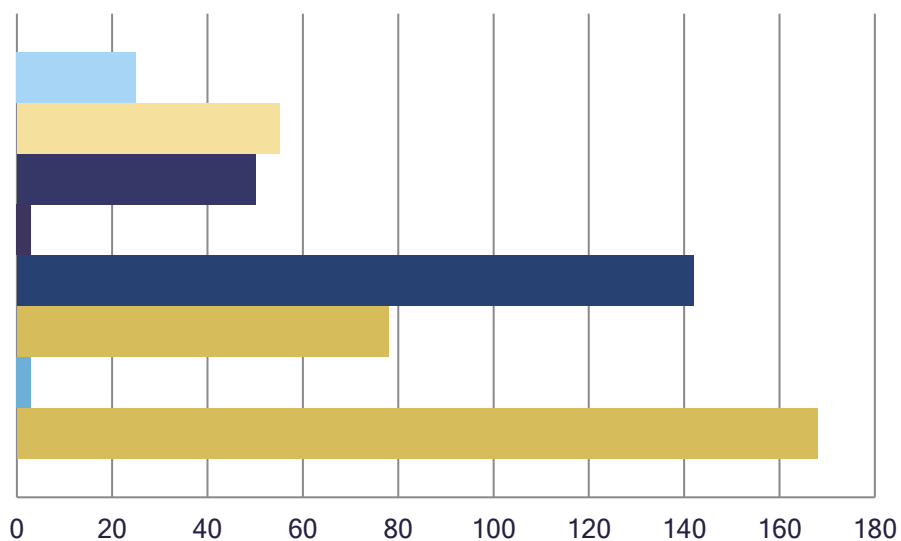

Academic Activities

Series of Six (01- Day) Capacity Building Training Sessions of the Staff posted at Information Kiosks/Facilitation Centers

To improve access to information facility for the litigant public, the Peshawar High Court vide letter No. 18453-587/ADMN dated 17/12/2021 directed the Academy to design and rollout crash courses for the staff posted at Information KIOSK/Facilitation Centers at the Principal Seat, Benches, Circuit Benches of the Peshawar High Court, District and Tehsil Courts.

To conduct a Training Needs Assessment (TNA) and to identify the performance requirements as well as the knowledge, skills, and attitude required of the staff posted at such centers, the faculty of the Academy visited the Information KIOSK centers of Peshawar High Court and District Courts, Peshawar.

Based on the TNA, the Academy devised a comprehensive training module and rolled out a series of six (06) one-day training programs held on the 15th, 17th, 19th, 22nd, 24th, and 26th of January, 2022. The training encompassed both theoretical and practical aspects of facilitation at Information KIOSK.

Objectives:

- *To increase the knowledge of the staff regarding Information Kiosk System in both theory & practice, with a focus on the facilitation of litigants;*
- *to refine professional skills for effective and efficient delivery of services; and*
- *to motivate the staff towards exploring and utilizing tools for the achievement of organizational targets.*



01-Day Training on Professional Responsibilities and Legal Ethics for Newly Inducted Lawyers from District Bar Association Peshawar at Judicial Complex Peshawar

20th January 2022

A formal request was made by the Peshawar Bar Association for conducting training of young lawyers in Bar Room of the District Bar Peshawar. In June 2021, a delegation led by President District Bar Association Peshawar met the Chief Justice, Peshawar High Court and requested for specialized trainings for newly inducted lawyers.

In this respect, record note of the meeting was received from the Peshawar High Court, with the directions of the Chief Justice, Peshawar High Court/ Chairman BoG,

of the Academy to arrange trainings for the newly inducted lawyers on specialized subjects including soft skills like etiquettes, mannerism, and professional responsibilities.

- motivate the trainees towards exploring and utilizing tools for the achievement of institutional targets.



01-Day Training of Law Officers of the Office of the Advocate General, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa

19th February 2022

The Law Officers are appointed under the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Appointment of Law Officers Act, 2014. They play a crucial role in the government business. They perform important functions and duties under the aegis of the Advocate General - from providing legal opinions on matters referred to the office of Advocate General by the Provincial Government to representation of the Provincial Government before the Superior Courts.

The need for capacity building of Law Officers was highlighted by the Advocate General, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa in 10th meeting of the Board of Governors (BoG) of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Judicial Academy. The proposed training was approved in its 11th meeting by the BoG.

The 5th Pre-Service Training (PST) for Civil Judges-cum-Judicial Magistrates for 1st Batch comprising of thirty-six (36) newly inducted Civil Judges-cum-Judicial Magistrates was rolled out from 14th March to 16th April 2022, with the support of UNDP Pakistan.

06-Day Training on “Capacity Building of Staff of Excise, Taxation & Narcotics Control Department”

18th -23rd July, 2022 (Batch-I)

The emphasis of the training was on professional ethics & conduct of the investigation officers, Orientation on the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Control of Narcotics Substances, Act 2019, relevant provision of P.P.C, Cr.P.C, Qanun-e-Shahadat Order, 1984, besides other matters pertaining to forensics examination of contraband etc.



For more in-depth information regarding the working of Forensic Science Laboratory, a visit of the laboratory was also arranged, where the trainees were briefed about the detailed procedure from the receipt of sample to preparation of expert report/opinion in Narcotics cases. At the end of 06-day training, certificates were distributed amongst the participants.

Knowledge Sharing Session on Banking Laws

The inaugural session was followed by formal academic session including discourses on

Legal & Regulatory Framework for Regulated Entities, State Bank of Pakistan Act, 1956, Banking Companies ordinance, 1962, and legal framework for the Recovery of Advances, etc.

The 04-day session concluded with concluding ceremony graced by Syed Irfan Ali,

Managing Director, Deposit Protection Corporation, State Bank of Pakistan. At the end, the participants were conferred with certificates.



04-Day Training on Legal Ethics & Professional Responsibilities for Newly Inducted Lawyers

Feedback

The feedback of the participants is summed up as under:

- *Duration of the training should be enhanced to at least one-month, and*
- *there should be more emphasis on specialized subjects like GBV laws*





03-Week Post-Promotion Training for Senior Civil Judges/Aala Illaqa Qazis

26th September - 15th October, 2022

Statutory post-promotion training of Senior Civil Judges/Aala Illaqa Qazis was rolled out by Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Judicial Academy. Twenty-five (25) promoted Senior Civil Judges/Aala Illaqa Qazis participated in the training. The training commenced with a formal ceremony graced by Mr. Justice Qaiser Rashid Khan, hon'ble the Chief Justice, Peshawar High Court, Peshawar/Chairman, Board of Governors of the Academy as chief guest. He was accompanied by the Registrar

and Principal Staff Officers of Peshawar High Court. Ms. Farah Jamshed, Director General of the Academy presided over the ceremony. Dean Faculty and Directors of the Academy were also in attendance. In her inaugural address, the Director General welcomed the hon'ble guests and the participants. She highlighted the objectives of the training and added that specialized subjects such as "Role of Judiciary in Mitigating Climate Change and its impact" and "Personal Well-being and leadership skills" are also included in the course modules.

While addressing the trainees, the chief guest remarked that the Senior Civil Judges have a long way to tread upon and hoped that they will set forth values and the metrics to improve the general prospective of the litigant public in judicial system.

Objectives:

The training was designed with objectives to:

- *orient and equip trainees with skills for effective performance of judicial, administrative and financial responsibilities as highlighted by the Peshawar High Court;*
- *understanding the leadership skills and becoming adept at art of public administration and human resource management.*
- *strengthen skills on Public Finance Management, Planning and Development; and*
- *make trainees Climate and Gender Justice responsive.*



The inaugural ceremony was followed by a formal group photo session, whereafter, hon'ble the chief guest planted a tree sapling in the Academy to highlight the importance of remedial steps to thwart devastating effects of climate change.



Later in the day, the formal academic session begins with the discourse of Justice (R) Mr. Nasir-ul-Mulk, former Chief Justice of Pakistan, on “Judicial Decision Making”.



The post-promotion training as per statutory requirements was designed to enhance the personal and professional knowledge, skills and attitude (KSA) of the newly promoted Senior Civil Judges/Aala Illaqa Qazis. The focus of the training was also on improving their ethical and moral standards. The training course covered three thematic areas: ‘Substantive and Adjective Laws’, ‘Court and Case Management’, and ‘Specialized Subjects’ like forensics, research methodology, attitudes, art of creative writing, stress management and IT skills. Feedback:

- *More focus should be given to topics on financial, budget, recruitment and procurement and their time duration may be extended.*
- *The duration of training may be extended to five weeks and training days in a week be reduced to 05 days per week.*
- *Apart from academics, the mock activities are more prolific.*
- *Academic modules were very good catering to needs and requirements in terms of legal guidance and proficiency skills. However some topics such as pre-trial criminal proceedings S.30 Cr.P.C powers, civil accounts time same could not be materialized due to paucity of time which needs detailed deliberations.*
- *Overwhelming participants stressed the need for a good friendly environment and personal grooming of the officers in a congenial environment.*



06-Day Training on “Capacity Building of Staff of Excise, Taxation & Narcotics Control Department”

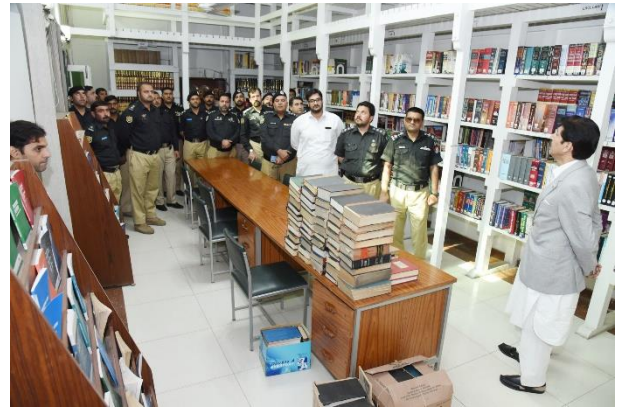

Welcoming the joint request of both organizations, 02-day activity was rolled out by the Academy for twenty-five (25) participants including twenty (20) Judicial Officers, one (01) Lawyer, three (03) Police officials, and three (03) Public Prosecutors from various districts across the province.



The inaugural ceremony was presided over by Ms. Farah Jamshed, Director General, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Judicial Academy and attended by members of JPP & RSIL besides the faculty members of the Academy. In her inaugural address, the Director General welcomed the participants and acknowledged the efforts of JPP & RSIL for organizing the session with the aim to sensitize the participants about issues involving various human right treaties, evolution of international jurisprudence to ensure their protection with a focus on the right to life, freedom from arbitrary arrest and detention, fair trial and due process, and protection against torture, etc.



During 02-day activity, the resource persons engaged the participants in understanding the legal framework of human rights in criminal justice system of Pakistan with on areas as specified in the concept note, besides providing insight to understand the concept of “I am human”.

At the end of the 02-day activity, certificates were conferred upon the participants.



Training on Gender-Based Violence Laws: Understanding and Dynamics

7th - 8th December 2022

Two Day Training on “Gender Based Violence (GBV) Laws: Understanding and Dynamics” was held on 7th and 8th December, 2022, at Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Judicial Academy with the support of UN Women.

Eighteen (18) lawyers from districts Abbottabad, Bajaur, Dir Lower, Haripur, Mohmand and Peshawar were nominated by their respective Bar(s) for the training.

The 02-day activity formally concluded on 8.12. 2022 in a ceremony graced by hon’ble Mr. Justice Qaiser Rashid Khan, Chief Justice, Peshawar High Court / Chairman, Board of Governors of the Academy as the chief guest. The Registrar, Peshawar High Court, Principal Staff Officers of the High Court, Dean Faculty and Directors of the Academy were also in attendance on the occasion. Ms. Zainab Qaiser, Head of Sub-Office Khyber Pakhtunkhwa UN-Women, and Ms. Rakhshanda Naz, Ombudsperson Khyber Pakhtunkhwa for Protection against Harassment of Women at the Workplace were also present.

CHAPTER 4

RESEARCH & PUBLICATION

One of the aims of the Academy is to provide judicial education and research in the field of law and judicial studies, besides, promoting research culture and human resource development through research led judicial education.

The Academy publishes its bi-annual Newsletters, Annual Report, Bench Book and also provide assistance to the Academic Wing in designing and conducting pre and post evaluation of every training activity for grading the overall impact of the training and for designing future training modules. It also provides assistance in preparation of training reports.

Analysis Of the Research Papers Authored by Judicial Officers

In order to cultivate the culture of research at the level of district judiciary, the Peshawar High Court, vide letter Endst: No. SDJ/PHC/REG/26-V.II-(1-3)/5522 dated 07-10-2019 instructed the District & Sessions Judges to assign different topics concerning Administration of Justice to the Judicial Officers for writing of research papers. The research papers of the judicial officers were directed to be presented in the monthly meeting of the judicial officers and the minutes of the meeting along with the copy of the same shall be sent to the High Court as well as to the Academy for research analysis. In this background, the Chairman approved the constitution and composition of the Research Committee with permission to engage a co-opted member, if so deemed appropriate by the Chairperson:

i.	Dean Faculty, KPJA	Chairperson
ii.	Senior Director Research & Publication, KPJA	Member
iii.	Director Instruction-I, KPJA	Member
iv.	Principal, Khyber Law College or his nominee	Member
v.	Research & Publication Officer, KPJA	Member/Secretary

Dr. Khurshid Iqbal, District & Sessions Judge, being an expert was engaged as a co-opted member of the committee.

The research papers received by the Academy are under scrutiny/analysis of the Committee and will be published on the Academy's website and in the journal after approval. Preparatory arrangements for publication of the Journal are also under consideration of the Committee.

Library

The Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Judicial Academy has a state-of-the-art library enriched with 5000 books, periodicals, journals, research studies and other reading materials on Law, Literature, History, and Islamic Law.

The reading room and collections are available to the faculty members, participants of training courses, employees of the Academy, and researchers, among others, during regular library hours.

The library has access to PLD law-site. Links of fifty (50) journals are also available on the Academy's website, and through such sources more than 5000 books can be accessed. This year subscription of PLD Journals and PLD law site, accessioning of donated books, updated the library books with latest amendments, purchase of latest statutes were also made by the Academy.

The Academy is also in the process of up-grading its library by making it accessible online.

CHAPTER 5

INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY

The Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Judicial Academy is equipped with Information Technology (IT) infrastructure. Offices, class rooms, auditorium, hostel are connected with local area network (LAN). Wi-Fi facility is also available in the Academy and its hostel to facilitate the trainee participants.

The Academy has its official website which is regularly maintained, updated and improved through the official web developer of the Academy. The catalogue of the library is automated and its software is indigenously programmed at the Academy. This catalogue is uploaded to the website and is accessible to the general public. Similarly, an asset tracking system has also been designed and programmed by the Academy's programmer. It keeps track of all movable assets of the Academy and it is updated through barcode readers.

The IT wing has also designed payroll software, which is operative at the elementary level.

CHAPTER 6

RADIO MEEZAN FM 96.6

The role of media in information sharing is growing spectacularly with recognition of the right to information and fundamental rights enshrined in the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973. Among the mass media in recent time, role of FM radio is undeniable.

As a non-commercial non-political facility, the Academy operates its Radio Meezan under the PEMRA rules. The transmission frequency allotted to the Radio is FM 96.6. The coverage of the Radio is presently extended to district Peshawar and the adjacent areas. The Academy is considering extension of frequency in consultation with PEMRA for broader coverage.

The Radio Meezan FM broadcast its programs as per the following format:

Programs Format

- **News Bulletins**

Radio Meezan broadcasts news bulletins of 10 minutes in Pashto and Urdu.

Objectives of Radio Meezan are to create:

- *Awareness among citizens about fundamental human rights.*
- *Awareness among citizens about their rights and responsibilities in the existing system of law.*
- *Awareness about rights of children, and minorities, women and weaker segments of society.*
- *Encouraging access to Human Rights Cell of the Peshawar High Court.*
- *Public forum to seek legal advice on solution of disputes.*
- *Acquainting citizens with the laws, rules and regulations of the country.*
- *Educate and interpret public about the country's legal system.*

Broadcast Timing

08:00 am to 11:00 am

03:00 pm to 07:00 pm

- **News reports**

It consists of the News about courts proceedings, human rights issues, activities and events of the Academy, International days e.g. Labor Day, Women's Day etc.

- **News Packages**

The news packages include pertinent law and court related stories, seminars, workshops, trainings, visits, inaugurations and reports of the academic activities of the Academy.

Coverage

The Transmission of Radio Meezan FM 96.6 can be heard in Peshawar and its suburbs. Radio Meezan operates its transmission on 50 Watt, as per PEMRA rules and license.

- **Discussion/ Lecture Forum**

At various discussion forums, lectures are delivered by renowned lawyers, jurists and constitutional experts on law related topics.

Besides, following miscellaneous program segments are also part of transmission.

- Imparting general knowledge about the legal system of Pakistan;
- Interesting historical moments about law;
- Quizzes about legal systems;
- Socio-cultural and economic activities.

CHAPTER 7

MAINTENANCE, REPAIR AND DEVELOPMENT

Maintenance and Repair (M&R) Works

In pursuance of the decision taken by the Board of Governors in its 11th meeting held on 12.6.2020, PC-I drawn up by the C&W Department was approved by the DDWP headed by the Registrar, Peshawar High Court, on 03.11.2020. Administrative Approval was granted by the Competent Authority on 14.11.2020. To implement the decision, C&W Department invited tenders, awarded the contract after technical sanction regarding the execution of the work. An amount of Rs 4.00 million sanctioned by the Finance Committee of the Academy was transferred to the C&W department for M&R work. Around 80% of the work has been carried out and the exact quantity & quality of work done will be measured, checked, and reported by the C&W Department. A satisfactory work completion will be issued by the Academy only after a thorough inspection and clearance report by the C&W Department which is still awaited.

Acquisition of 150-kanal land in Regi Model Town, Peshawar

The Peshawar Development Authority had approved allotment of 150-Kanal land for the construction of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Judicial Academy at Regi Model Town, Peshawar @ Rs 2,500,000/- per Kanal vide letter No. 3.01.77/47/10 dated 22/05/2012. A sum of Rs 400.00 million was reflected in ADP for the subject scheme for the year 2015-16.

However, In the meeting of the PDWP held on 15.9.2017 under the chairmanship of the Additional Chief Secretary, following decisions were made:

- The project was approved at the reduced cost of Rs 290.00 million.
- Instead of 150 Kanals, only 95 Kanals were allowed.
- The possession charges were deleted from PC-I

In light of the minutes of the meeting, an Administrative Approval was issued for Rs290.00 million by the Peshawar High Court. The same stands reflected in the ADP Scheme.

Subsequently, in compliance with the decision of Board of Governors (BoG) taken in its 9th meeting held on 22.4.2019, a fresh summary was moved to the Provincial Government for increasing the area of land from 95-Kanal to 150-Kanal, which was duly approved by the Chief Minister, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.

In pursuance of the approval of the Chief Minister, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, the Board of the Peshawar Development Authority (PDA), approved the allotment of 150-Kanal land for the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Judicial Academy at Regi Model Town, Peshawar at the following rates:-

The Secretary to Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Communication & Works Department, Peshawar was requested to revise the PC-I/Detail Cost Estimates in accordance with the cost of land and other matters incidental or ancillary thereto in the light of aforementioned approval of 150 Kanal of land so that the same be placed before PDWP for consideration and approval.

On-Campus Hostel Facility

This year, the Academy formally took possession of its On-Campus hostel and it was made operational and functional for the 1st time for participants of 5th Pre-Service Training of Newly Inducted Civil Judges-cum-Judicial Magistrates in March, 2022.

Solarization of the Academy

In 13th meeting, the Board was apprised about the solarization initiative taken-up by the Academy with Provincial Electric Inspector and the Pakhtunkhwa Energy Development Organization (PEDO). Appreciating the efforts made by the Academy, the Chair instructed the Additional Registrar (Admin), Peshawar High Court,

Peshawar, to take-up the matter with PEDO on priority basis for solarization of the Academy and Peshawar High Court (PHC).

With the indulgence of PHC, a scheme for solarization of PHC and Academy was included in the ADP 2022-23. The PEDO conducted survey of the Academy on 04-10-2022 and submitted Technical Proposal as under:

The PEDO has proposed on-grid solar system with Net Metering facility and has estimated the gestation (payback period) as 3.64 years.

The Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Energy & Power Department (KPEP) has prepared and submitted PC-I/DCE through the PHC for review in light of requirements of the Academy. The estimated cost of the project is 26.33 million.

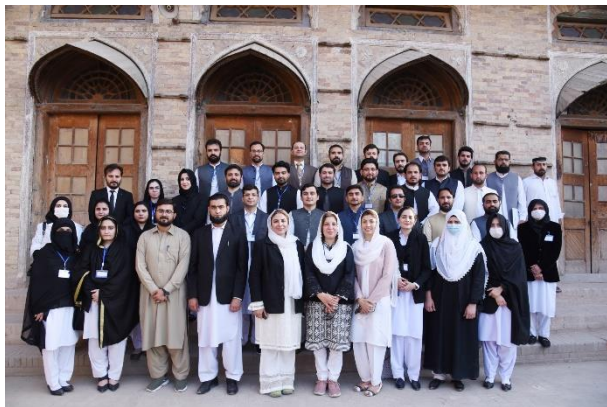

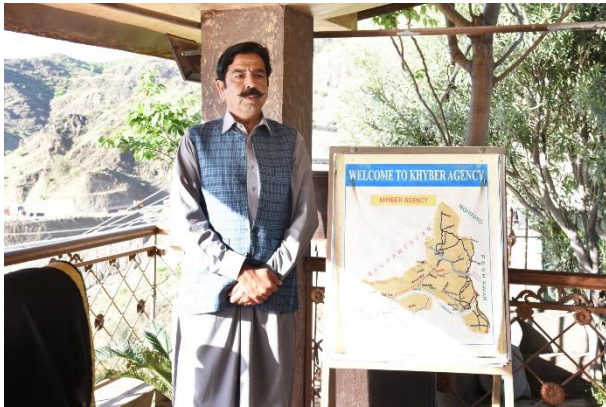
The participants were encouraged to prepare separate visits reports in groups.

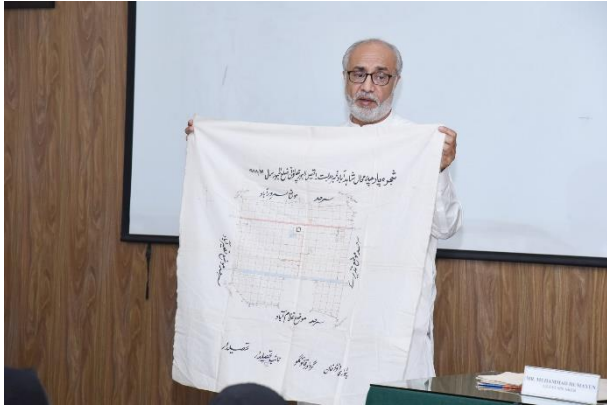

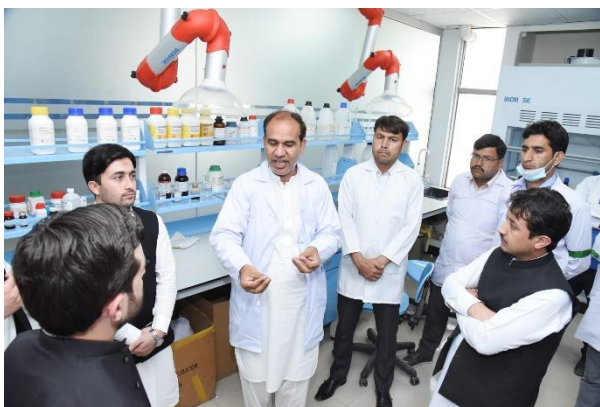

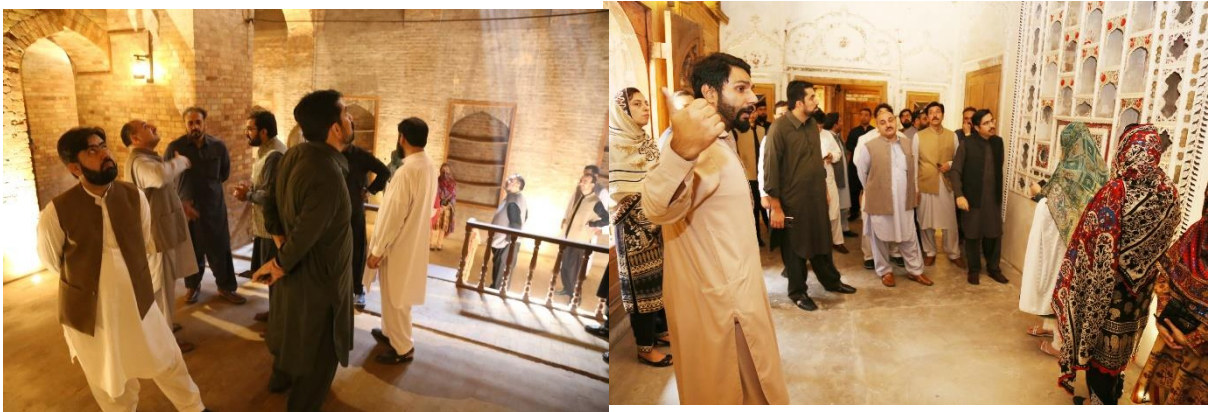


Tour of Participants of 03-Week Post-Promotion Statutory Training of Senior Civil Judges/*Aala Illaqa Qazis*
