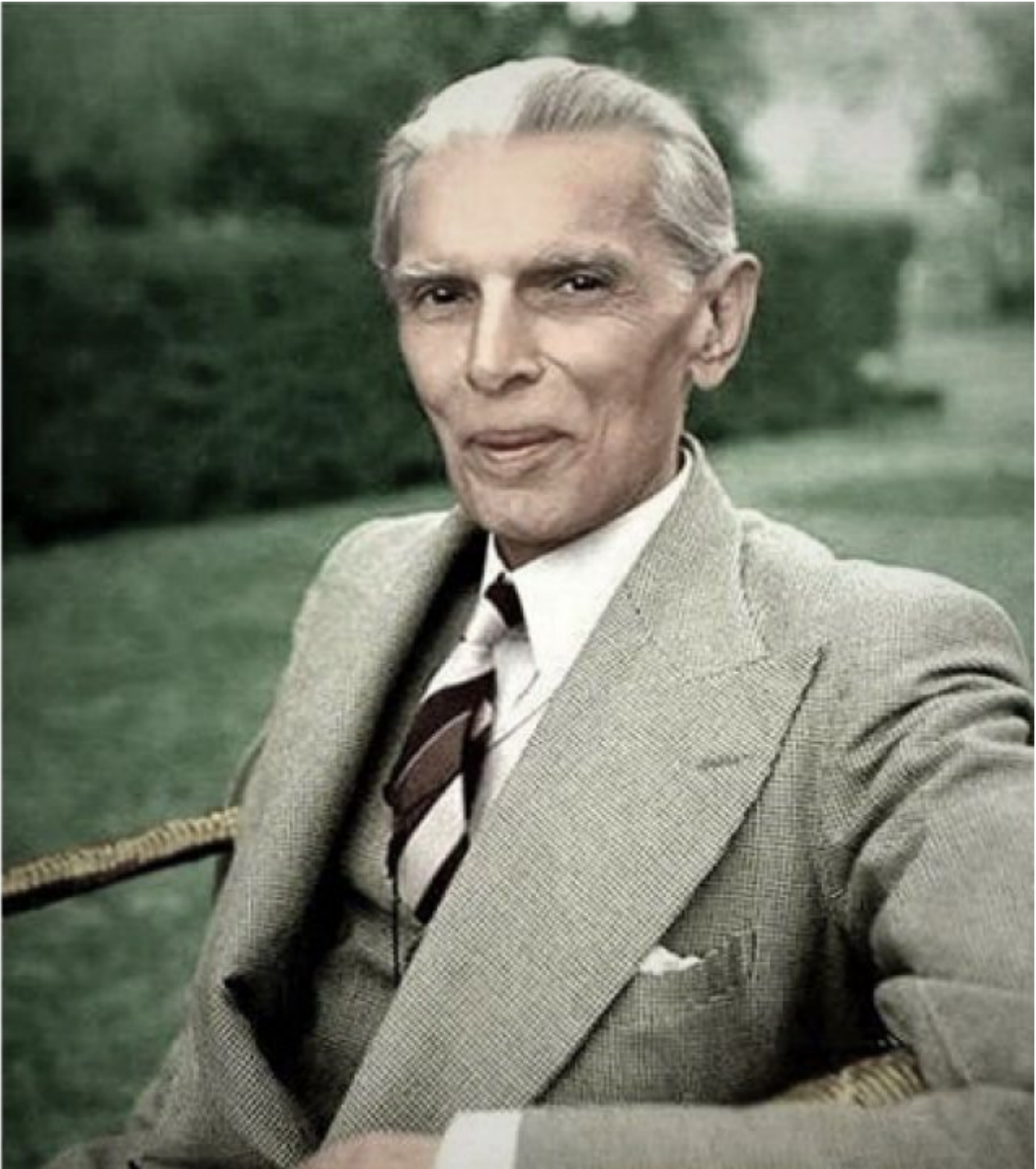



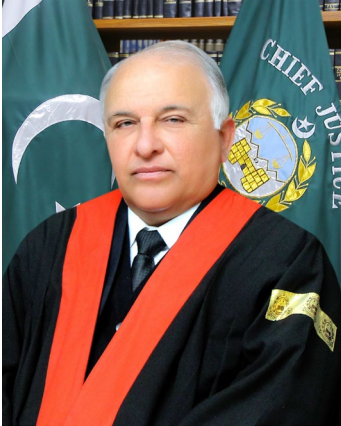

Born on 31.03.1961 at Thana, Malakand, hon'ble Mr. Justice Qaiser Rashid Khan (late) obtained Law degree from Khyber Law College, University of Peshawar in 1984. He was enrolled as an Advocate of Peshawar High Court in 1991 and of Supreme Court of Pakistan in 2008. He worked as Additional Advocate General, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa on 17.03.2008. He was elevated to the Bench as an Additional Judge on 02.08.2011 and got confirmed on 12.06.2013. He took oath as Chief Justice of Peshawar High Court on 16.09.2020 and retired on 30.03.2023.



Hon'ble Mr. Justice Rooh ul Amin Khan

31.03.2023 - 31.03.2023

Born on 01.04.1961 at Chamkani, Peshawar, hon'ble Mr. Justice Rooh ul Amin Khan, graduated in Law from Khyber Law College, University of Peshawar in 1985. He was enrolled as Advocate of Peshawar High Court in 1989 and of Supreme Court of Pakistan, 2001. He remained as Deputy Attorney General of Pakistan and Deputy Advocate General, NWFP. He was elevated to the Bench as Additional Judge in July 2012 and confirmed as permanent judge of Peshawar High Court in March, 2014. He took oath as acting Chief Justice of Peshawar High Court on 31.03.2023 and got retired on the same day.



Hon'ble Ms. Justice Musarrat Hilali

12.05.2023 – 06-07-2023

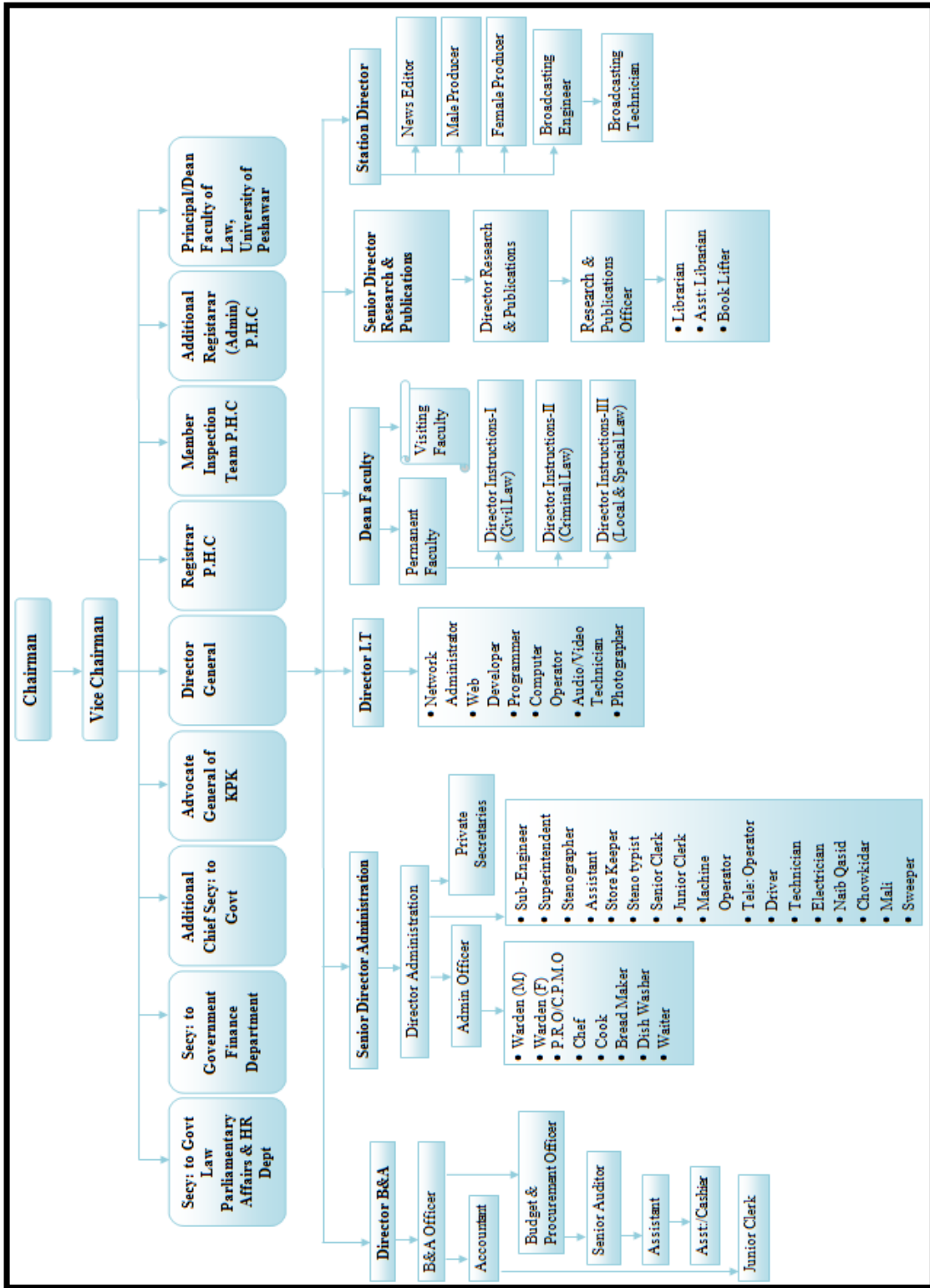
Born on 08.08.1961 at Peshawar, hon'ble Ms. Justice Musarrat Hilali received Law degree from Khyber Law College, University of Peshawar. She enrolled as an Advocate of High Court in 1988 and of Supreme Court of Pakistan in 2006. She was the first female Additional Advocate General of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, the first female Chairperson of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Environmental Protection Tribunal and first female Ombudsmen for Protection against harassment of women at workplace. She was elevated to the Bench as Additional Judge of the Peshawar High Court on 26.03.2013 and confirmed as permanent judge on 13.03.2014. She took oath as Chief Justice on 01.04.2023 whereafter, she was elevated to the Supreme Court as Judge Supreme Court on 05.07.2023

ROLE AND POWERS OF THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS

The Board of Governors shall:

- a.** exercise supervision and control over the affairs of the Academy;
- b.** lay down the policy and program for training;
- c.** initiate, modify, adopt the curriculum, courses, modules, clinics, for orientation and training;
- d.** organize and carry out the activities and performance of the authority;
- e.** consider and approve the annual budget and revised budget estimate of the Academy;
- f.** manage financial affairs;
- g.** cause proper books of account to be maintained for all sums of money received and expenditure incurred by the Academy and arrange for audit of accounts;
- h.** specify qualifications, conditions of service and matters relating to the director general, faculty members and staff of the Academy;
- i.** create, abolish, suspend and upgrade posts;
- j.** purchase, hire, construct or alter any building for the use of the Academy;
- k.** acquire, hold, control, maintain, administer, construct or dispose of any property, or other assets;
- l.** acquire, maintain and dispose of any vehicle;
- m.** affiliate the Academy with other academies, institutions and centers of the federal, provincial or foreign government and organizations;
- n.** appoint advisors, consultants and experts and specify their terms and conditions;
- o.** appoint or hire permanent or visiting faculty and specify their terms and conditions; and
- p.** decide any other matter ancillary or incidental to aims and objectives of the Academy.

- In compliance with the directions of the august Supreme Court of Pakistan dated 11-10-2018 in HR Case No. 18200-K/2018, the Hon'ble Chief Justice of Peshawar High Court was pleased to **appoint Mr. Justice Mohamamd Ibrahim Khan, Hon'ble Judge of Peshawar High Court as "Commission" on 12-10-2018** to probe into the despicable tragedy of APS incident which dismayed not only the whole nation but attracted condemnation from the people all over the world. It was the heartrending APS incident of December 16th, 2014 in which, the blooms and blossoms of Army Public School and College Warsak Road Peshawar were besieged and ruthlessly massacred by a group of maniac terrorists. **147** innocent souls, including 132 children, besides teachers and staff, embraced martyrdom in appalling manner, while **180** were injured.

The commission conducted extensive probe and examined 102 aggrieved people/complainant(s) besides, recording the statements of government functionaries of all ranks and honour from the Armed Forces, Bureaucracy and Police. They include, besides

others; Lt. General Rtd. Hidayat-ur-Rehman, the then Corps Commander 11-Corps, Maj. General Inam Haider, the then Brigadier who conducted the “Court of Inquiry” and Maj. General Innayat Hussain, the then commander 102 Infantry Brigade who conducted the operation in APS. It was in fact, Maj. General. Shakirullah, then Brigadier-102, 11Corps who had offered himself as a Focal Person from Military’s/MoD side and his services facilitated appearance of the top-notch Army officers before the Commission for their statements.

The Commission delved deeply into the grievances and submitted its detailed and all-encompassing report of 525 pages to the Hon’ble Chief Justice, Supreme Court of Pakistan.

ADDITIONAL ACCOUNTS: -

- In pursuance of recommendations by the Finance Committee of the Academy held on 23.02.2023 and after approval by the Board of Governors of the Academy in the 14th meeting held on 21.06.2023, Finance Department, Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa agreed to allocate funds amounting Rs. 200.000 million as grant-in-aid for the current financial year 2023-24.
- During 2023, a sum of Rs. 1,769,685/- was earned from trainings, workshops and seminars. After approval of Hon'ble the Chief Justice, Peshawar High Court, Peshawar/Chairman, the earning and balance of Rs. 6,184,000/- was transferred to Endowment Fund in March, 2023 for strengthening the same.
- A profit of Rs. 46,000,000/- is expected from the investment made by the Academy towards Endowment Fund kept in Bank of Khyber, Peshawar High Court Branch, Peshawar.

ENDOWMENT FUND

To make the Academy self-sustainable and to reduce its dependency on Provincial Government, Endowment Fund was created during the year 2012-13. Initially, an amount of Rs 50.000 million was released by the Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa as seed money. The profit & earnings of the Academy were re-invested over the period, 2013-23 as per details given below: -

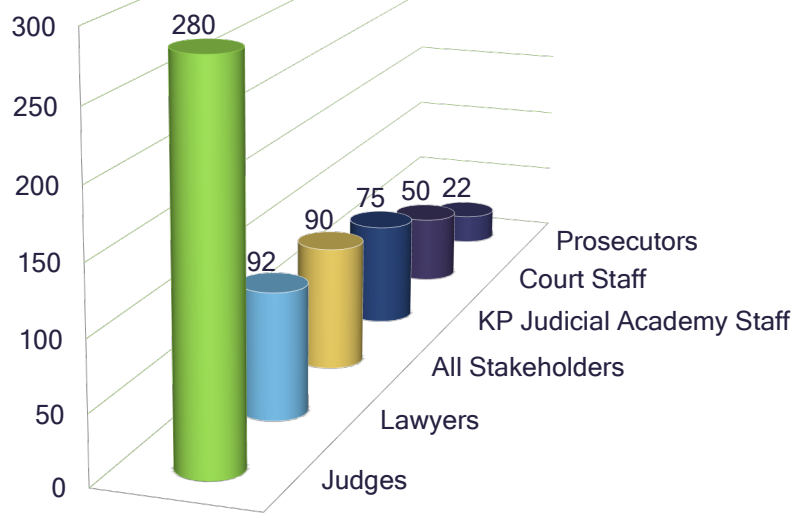

Lawyers throughout the world are specialized professionals who place the interest of their clients above their own, and strive to obtain respect for the Rule of Law. They have to combine a continuous update on legal developments with service to their clients, respect for the courts, and the legitimate aspiration to maintain a reasonable standard of living. To achieve that, the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Judicial Academy organized a week-long training program for lawyers from Malakand Division including Tehsil Kabal, Swat. The Training was attended by twenty-two (22) lawyers from the region.

02-DAY CAPACITY BUILDING TRAINING FOR JUDGES OF SPECIAL COURTS ON “ANTI-RAPE LEGISLATION” JANUARY 30 - 31, 2023

Awareness and education are the most effective and meaningful ways to prevent rape. On the same strength involvement of justice sector stakeholders are necessary to discuss the roadblocks to justice faced by the victims.



Having such vision and while honouring formal request of Asma Jehangir Legal Aid Cell (AGHS) vide letter dated: November 26, 2022, the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Judicial Academy, in collaboration with AGHS, organized a two day (02) specialized training for the trial court judges on the Anti-Rape laws. Twenty-three (23) Additional District and Sessions Judges from across the province attended the training.



The training commenced on January 30, 2023. Mr. Muhammad Shoib, Dean Faculty, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Judicial Academy (KPJA) welcomed the participants. During his keynote talk, he expressed his expectation for an interactive session on capacity building for the trainees. Ms. Nida Aly, Executive Director, AGHS, highlighted its objectives.

Focus of the activity included gender sensitization, sexual gender-based violence cases and roadblocks to justice, ingredients of rape, Anti- Rape (Investigation and Trial) Act 2021, evidentiary matters, the KP Witness Protection Act, 2021, case and courtroom management and managing vicarious trauma exposure to judges dealing with sexual gender-based violence cases.



Director General of the Academy appreciated the participation of the trainees and the entire team of AGHS in making the training a success.

03-DAY TRAINING FOR JUDICIAL OFFICER OF DISTRICT JUDICIARY ON “CONDUCT, ATTITUDE, BEHAVIOUR, MANAGING STRESS, MAINTAINING HEALTH & WELL-BEING” (BATCH-I) MARCH 2-4, 2023



A professional attitude promotes a harmonious work environment, builds trust and credibility, and contributes to effective communication, teamwork, and collaboration viz-a-viz reduces stress.

To inculcate the qualities of judging with compassion and impart techniques for the management of stress, the Peshawar High Court through letter No.17253/ Admn dated 22.12.2022 highlighted the need for imparting training on Conduct, Attitude, Behavior, Managing Stress and Conflict at Workplace. The Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Judicial Academy organized the first-ever three-day training on the subject from March 2 to March 4, 2023.



Twenty-four (24) judges, including Senior Civil Judges and Civil Judges cum Judicial Magistrates from various districts of the province, attended the training.

Effective dispute resolution is an important part of good business management. Having a clear understanding of commercial dispute resolution law helps businesses to avoid conflicts and prevent unavoidable conflicts from escalation; ultimately resulting in the economic development of a country.

A two-day workshop was held on "Commercial Disputes Resolution: Concept and Understanding" at Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Judicial Academy on March 20 and 21, 2023. Judges of Commercial Courts, District Attorneys, Advocates, representatives from the Sarhad and



Khyber Chamber of Commerce and Government Officers of the Commerce, Industries and Technical Education Department were amongst the participants.

ONLINE KNOWLEDGE SHARING SESSIONS ON “ALTERNATIVE DISPUTE RESOLUTION (ADR) - LEGAL FRAMEWORK”

APRIL 11-18, 2023



In Pakistan, ADR has become an essential part of the legal system, supplementing the traditional court processes.

The Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Alternate Dispute Resolution Act, 2020, and rules framed thereunder in 2021, were given effect across the province in 2022.

Pursuant to decision of the Supreme Court ADR Committee meeting held on 01.02.2023, the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Judicial Academy undertook a series of online Knowledge Sharing Sessions, spanning from April 11 to 18, 2023. Objectives of the sessions included orientation on the Alternative Dispute Resolution (ADR) legal framework and the sharing of experiences and challenges for future in-person trainings.



The District and Sessions Judges and Senior Civil Judges of the Merged Districts, Malakand Division, Central Districts, Hazara Division and Southern Districts of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa were the participants.

Ms. Nida Aly, Executive Director, AGHS gave brief introduction of training session and its objectives.

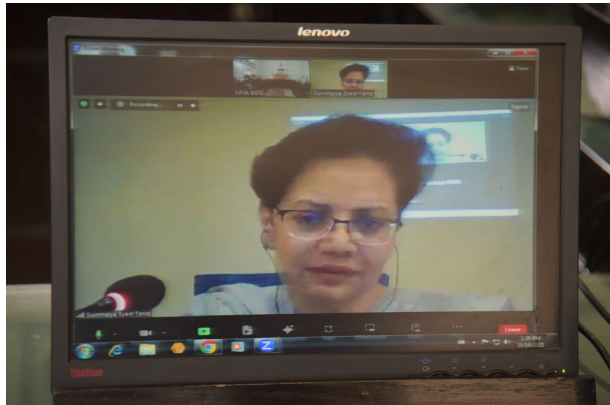

Participants were awarded certificates on completion of training.

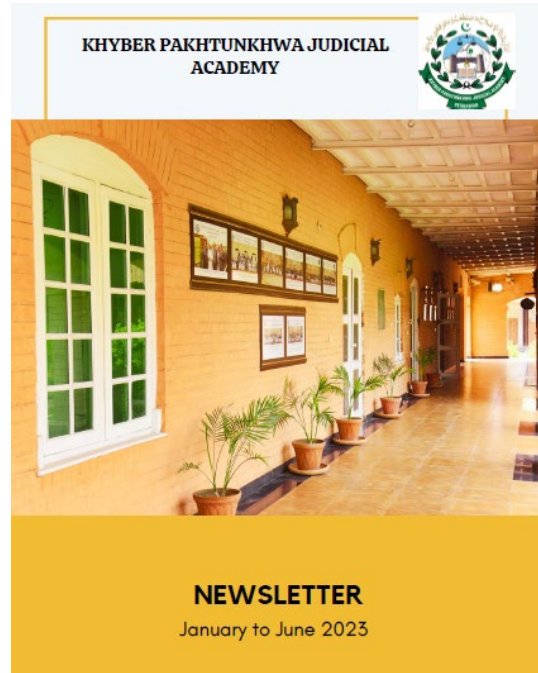
Class Representative and the Director General KPJA presented souvenirs to hon'ble the Chief Guest. Both the Director Generals also exchanged souvenirs.

CHAPTER 5

INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY

The Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Judicial Academy is equipped with Information Technology (IT) infrastructure. Offices, class rooms, auditorium, hostel are connected with local area network (LAN). Wi-Fi facility is also available in the Academy and its hostel to facilitate the trainee participants.

The Academy has its official website which is regularly maintained, updated and improved through the official web developer of the Academy. The catalogue of the library is automated and its software is indigenously programmed at the Academy. This catalogue is uploaded to the website and is accessible to the general public. Similarly, an asset tracking system has also been designed and programmed by the Academy's programmer. It keeps track of all movable assets of the Academy and it is updated through barcode readers.

All activities of the Academy are being shared on social media platforms to increase outreach.

The IT wing has also designed payroll software, which is operative at the elementary level.

CHAPTER 6

RADIO MEEZAN FM 96.6

In 2023, Radio Meezan, under the directives of the Station Director, meticulously curated and broadcasted a wide array of programs catering to legal education, societal awareness, and human rights advocacy. With the approval of the Director General, Radio Meezan embarked on a journey to disseminate legal knowledge and promote social justice through its diverse programming.

A total of 403 programs were uploaded to platforms such as Spotify and Podcasts, covering an extensive range of legal topics. Notable programs included "Banking Laws" and "Traffic kay Qawanin" with insights from Muhammad Ali, Advocate Supreme Court, Asif Raza and SP Traffic, Mrs. Shazia Shahid respectively. These programs provided invaluable insights into various legal aspects, ensuring accessibility to legal information for the public.

Furthermore, Radio Meezan's disseminated extensive information pertaining to child welfare and protection through launching programs like "Bacho ky Haqooq,". These programs delved into the rights of children and addressed critical issues such as child labor, child marriage, and juvenile justice. Another significant initiative was the program titled "Sinfi Imtiaz / Tashadud aur Qanon," focusing on gender-based violence and legal remedies to combat such atrocities.

Radio Meezan FM 96.6 also dedicated some programs to Alternative Dispute Resolution, law mechanisms, right to information, and right to Public Services, emphasizing the importance of transparency, accountability, and accessibility in governance.

In line with expanding horizon, Radio Meezan introduced new programs approved by the Director General, including "Mash'al e Rah" based on Mr. Zia ur Rehman's book, "Law Giving Versus in Quran and Sunnah". "Qanon Qadam Pa Qadam" discussing legislation by the Provincial Assembly, and "Qanon mai Auraton aur Baccho ka Muqam" focusing on women's and children's rights.

CHAPTER 7

MAINTENANCE, REPAIR & DEVELOPMENT

MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR (M&R) WORKS

Renovation

- Lecture Halls: Taking notice of regular appearance of cracks in the walls and floor of the Lecture Hall, attached offices, Auditorium, and allied facilities of the Academy, Secretary to the Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Communication & Works Department was requested through Letter No. 980/KPJA dated 11.08.2022 to depute for said inspection. The Sub Divisional Officer (SDO), C&W Department suggested for engaging the University of Engineering & Technology (UET), Peshawar for detailed survey of the building. Accordingly, the Chairman Department of Civil Engineering, UET Peshawar was approached vide letter No. 1247-49/KPJA dated 25.10.2022 to depute a team for inspection and report, whereupon, the UET has quoted Rs.684,000/- as consultancy fee to be deposited in advance through crossed cheque. The scheme was approved by the hon'ble Chairman on 29.11.2022.

Owing to the nature of cracks in the classroom and attached offices, all the activities were decided to be conducted in other rooms of the Academy.

The renovation work was started by installing multimedia, electrification and PVC paneling in available classroom. Since the building is more than one hundred years old, and required day-to-day maintenance, therefore, in order to minimize the expenditure and to reduce the effects of seepage, PVC panels was suggested and will be installed soon.

- Auditorium: For functioning of the Academy and to carry out various activities like inaugural and concluding ceremonies, syndicate discussion, workshops it was necessitated to select a proper space therefore, a room was selected as auditorium and its renovation work like electrification, installation of multimedia and PVC paneling was also done.
- Classroom-II: The conditions of the Classroom-II is not upto the standard for conducting any academic activity. By the end of this financial year, it is expected that the renovation work of Classroom-II would be finished and would be delivered to the Academy for future activities.

Green Belt on Canal Bank

The area around the canal passing through the Academy was in depilated condition and it was desired by the Director General to improve the beautification of the Academy, therefore, the area towards west of canal was transformed into green belt. During the visit of the Academy, the hon'ble Justice Qaiser Rashid Khan also planted Guava tree. His lordship has also gifted eight fox-tail palm trees which were planted at various spots adding color to the beautify of the Academy. The participant of various trainings have also contributed in landscaping of the Academy.

ACQUISITION OF 150-KANAL LAND IN REGI MODEL TOWN, PESHAWAR

The Peshawar Development Authority had approved allotment of 150-Kanal land for the construction of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Judicial Academy at Regi Model Town, Peshawar @ Rs 2,500,000/- per Kanal vide letter No. 3.01.77/47/10 dated 22/05/2012. A sum of Rs 400.00 million was reflected in ADP for the subject scheme for the year 2015-16.

However, In the meeting of the PDWP held on 15.9.2017 under the chairmanship of the Additional Chief Secretary, following decisions were made:

- The project was approved at the reduced cost of Rs 290.00 million.
- Instead of 150 Kanals, only 95 Kanals were allowed.
- The possession charges were deleted from PC-I

In light of the minutes of the meeting, an Administrative Approval was issued for Rs290.00 million by the Peshawar High Court. The same stands reflected in the ADP Scheme.

Subsequently, in compliance with the decision of Board of Governors (BoG) taken in its 9th meeting held on 22.4.2019, afresh summary was moved to the Provincial Government for increasing the area of land from 95-Kanal to 150-Kanal, which was duly approved by the Chief Minister, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.

In pursuance of the approval of the Chief Minister, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, the Board of the Peshawar Development Authority (PDA), approved the allotment of 150-Kanal land for the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Judicial Academy at Regi Model Town, Peshawar at the following rates:-

(i)	Total Cost of 95-Kanal Land at the rate of Rs 2,500,000/- Per Kanal	= Rs 237,500,000/-
	Already Paid Amount	= <u>Rs 10,000,000/-</u>
	Balance Amount	= Rs 227,500,000/-
(ii)	Total Cost of 55-Kanal Land at the rate of Rs 8,000,000/- Per Kanal	= <u>Rs 440,000,000/-</u>
	Grand Total	= Rs 667,500,000/-

The Secretary to Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Communication & Works Department, Peshawar was requested to revise the PC-I/Detail Cost Estimates in accordance with the cost of land and other matters incidental or ancillary thereto in the light of aforementioned approval of 150 Kanal of land so that the same be placed before PDWP for consideration and approval.

As approved, at Serial No.2 of the Minutes of fourteenth (14) meeting of the Board of Governors (BOG) the issue of possession is in process with DG PDA and it is expected that the issues would be resolved the possession of the land would be transferred to the Judicial Academy by the end of year 2024.

SOLARIZATION OF THE ACADEMY

The cost of electricity is increasing day by day putting huge financial burden on the Academy, and it is now one of the most important austerity measures of the Academy to install 83KW solar energy supply system.

In 13th meeting, the Board was apprised about the solarization initiative taken-up by the Academy with Provincial Electric Inspector and the Pakhtunkhwa Energy Development Organization (PEDO). Appreciating the efforts made by the Academy, the Chair instructed the Additional Registrar (Admin), Peshawar High Court, Peshawar, to take-up the matter with PEDO on priority basis for solarization of the Academy and Peshawar High Court (PHC).

With the indulgence of PHC, a scheme for solarization of PHC and Academy was included in the ADP 2022-23. The PEDO conducted survey of the Academy on 04-10-2022 and submitted Technical Proposal as under:

The PEDO has proposed on-grid solar system with Net Metering facility and has estimated the gestation (payback period) as 3.64 years.

The Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Energy & Power Department (KPEP) has prepared and submitted PC-I/DCE through the PHC for review in light of requirements of the Academy. The estimated cost of the project is 26.33 million. As approved, in the minutes of fourteenth (14) meeting of the Board of Governors (BOG), the hon'ble Peshawar High Court through letter No. A(a)25A(P&D)/DDW/169 Dated 19th January, 2024 has desired for the early release of funds from Finance Department. In this respect, Academy is in contact with PEDO.

This visit broadened the trainee judges' awareness of mental health-related challenges as well as importance of a compassionate and informed approach within the judicial system.



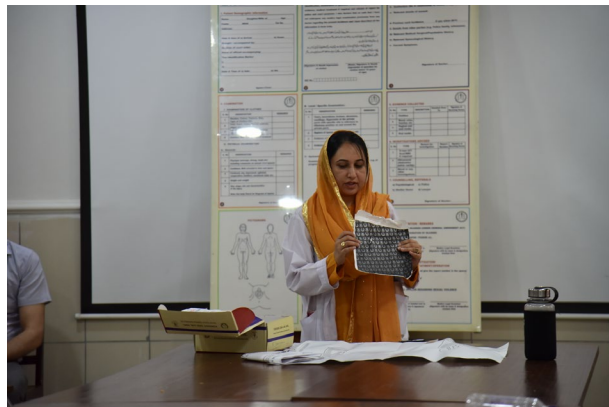
VISIT OF TRAINEE JUDGES TO KHYBER MEDICAL COLLEGE, PESHAWAR. MAY 17, 2023
